Location: On Big Sable Point in Ludington

State Park north of Ludington

Built in: 1867

Day Mark: White tower with black lantern room

and one black strip in the middle

Light Signature: Constant white light



Ludington North Breakwater Lighthouse

Location: At the end of the north break-

water in Ludington harbor

Built in: 1924

Day Mark: White tower with black lantern

room

Light Signature: Flashes green



Little Sable Point Lighthouse

Location: South of Silver Lake in Silver Lake

State Park near Mears

Built in: 1873

Day Mark: Red Brick with a black lantern

room

Light Signature: Its Third Order Fresnel Lens is

still in the tower, & the light

flashes white.



White River Light Station

Location: 25 miles north of Muskegon near

Whitehall

Built in: 1875

Day Mark: Cream brick with a black lantern

room

Light Signature: Its Fourth Order Fresnel Lens has

been reinstalled in the lantern

room, and the light is constant

white.
